1 Employers shall ensure that no lifting equipment leaves, is used, or is brought onto his undertaking unless it is provided with either:  
 (a) An EC Declaration of Conformity made not more than 12 months before the equipment was first put to use or

2 Physical evidence that the last thorough examination required to be carried out by the regulations, has been carried out  
 9(4) Where an employer receives an EC Declaration of Conformity with the lifting equipment, he shall keep the Declaration so long as he operates the lifting equipment  
 Reg. 9(1) and Reg 11(1) Employers shall keep a copy of the last Examination Report for 2 years, or until the next report is available, whichever is later  
 Reg 11(2) Item 5 may contain a reference to another publication (operator handbook, load chart....), providing that this is kept with the machine, to provide the details concerning the safe working load of the lifting equipment.
